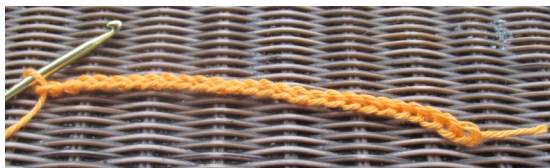


Reverse Join for working in the round



Start with the normal chain as directed in your pattern

Remove hook from working loop



Insert hook into first chain, from the bottom side. Being sure the chain has not twisted, draw the working loop through the first chain. Chain as directed in your pattern. As you work your stitches, you will use the loops that stand alone, leaving the two braided loops as a finished edge,



As you see from these last two pictures, the join is almost invisible. This allows top and bottom of your finished item to be virtually undistinguishable. The major difference is the amount of stretch.
